4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable Extinguishing Media	Water spray, CO ₂ , dry chemical, or alcohol-resistant foam.
Unsuitable Extinguishing Media	None known. Product is non-flammable.



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Specific Hazards	Product does not support combustion. Reaction with soft metals may produce hydrogen gas — a flammability hazard in enclosed spaces.
PPE for Firefighters	Full structural fire-fighting protective clothing. SCBA in enclosed spaces.



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6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal Precautions: Use appropriate PPE (see Section 8). Isolate the spill area. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Acid pH — use caution on metal surfaces.

Environmental Precautions: Prevent entry into waterways, sewers, or confined areas. Neutralize with sodium bicarbonate before disposal if required by local regulations.

Containment & Cleanup: Small spills: absorb with inert material (sand, vermiculite). Large spills: dike to contain. Transfer to approved waste containers. Flush area with water.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Safe Handling: Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Avoid prolonged contact with soft metals. Wash hands thoroughly after handling.

Safe Storage: Store at ambient temperature. Avoid freezing or high heat. Keep container tightly closed. Keep out of reach of children.

Incompatible Storage: Strong oxidizers, alkali, soft metals. Do not mix with bleach or chlorinated compounds.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS / PERSONAL PROTECTION

Engineering Controls: Normal room air circulation adequate for routine use. Local exhaust ventilation recommended in enclosed spaces. Provide eyewash station in the work area.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Eye / Face	Chemical splash goggles. Full face shield where splash risk exists.
Hand	Rubber or neoprene gloves.
Skin / Body	Chemical-resistant apron.
Respiratory	Not normally required. If needed in enclosed areas, use NIOSH-approved respirator.
